NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section 1 of section 355 of the Pondicherry Municipalities Act, 1973 and in supersession of the Notification dated 6-3-1998 published in the Official Gazette dated 24-4-1998, save as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Special Officer, Pondicherry Municipality hereby directs (*vide* his proceedings bearing No. PM/32/CS/97, dated 28-9-1999) that, on and from the date of publication of this notification, no place within the Municipal limits of Pondicherry Municipality shall be used for any of the purposes specified in the schedule appended to this notification without the licence of the Commissioner and except in accordance with the conditions specified in the licence.

2. This notification shall come into operation after sixty days from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

3. The persons intending to start new trade / industry on every such place shall within thirty days of the publication of such notification apply to the Commissioner for the licence for use of such a place for such purposes.

4. Every such licence shall expire at the end of the year unless for special reasons the Commissioner considers that it should expire at an earlier date, when it shall expire at such earlier date as may be specified therein.

Definition : — 'Year' means the financial year *i.e.* from 1st April to 31st March.

5. Application for renewal of such licences shall be made not less than thirty days and not more than ninety days before the end of every year and applications for licences for places to be newly opened shall be made not less than thirty days and not more than ninety days before they are opened.

6. The rate of fees for licences under section 355 and of fees for permissions under section 356 read with section 456 (2) of the Pondicherry Municipalities Act, 1973 are given in column (3) of the said Schedule below and they will come into force on the date of coming into force of this notification.

7. The fees specified in the schedule will apply only to the applications made in time. In the case of belated applications for licences and permissions under section 355 and 356 respectively of the said Act, the fee payable will be charged at 125% of the prescribed rates.

8. The Owner or Occupier of every such place already having trade licence shall have to pay the rates of licence fees at the time of renewal of licence for the forthcoming financial year.

9. When a licence is required for use of any premises to deal with more than one item of trade, licence fees shall be paid only for one of the items dealt with in that premises, for which highest licence fee is prescribed, but licence shall be obtained for all items of trade dealt with in that premises.

10. Proportionate licence fee will be levied by the Commissioner on the merits of the case. In respect of trades carried on without licence and detected, proportionate licence fee shall not apply.

11. Applications shall be accompanied with the receipt for the pre-payment of the prescribed fee for any such licence or permission. The acceptance of the pre-payment of the fee for any such licence or permission shall not entitle the person making such payment to the licence or permission but only to a refund of the fee in case of refusal of the licence or permission.

12. All licences or permissions issued shall be "Not transferable" from person to person.

13. Whoever uses a place for offensive or dangerous trade without a licence or contrary to licence or whoever constructs or establishes any factory, workshop or work-place without permission shall be liable to be prosecuted under section 449 read with Schedule XIII of the Pondicherry Municipalities Act, 1973.
